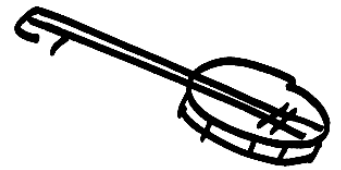


# Contra Dance!

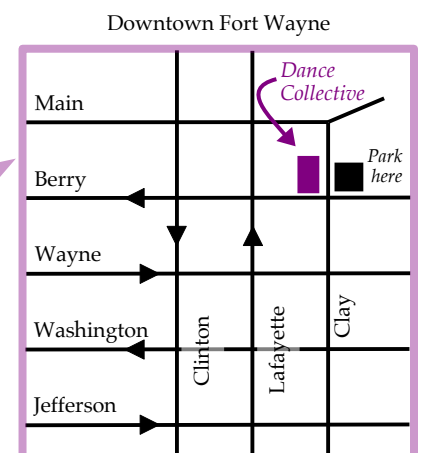
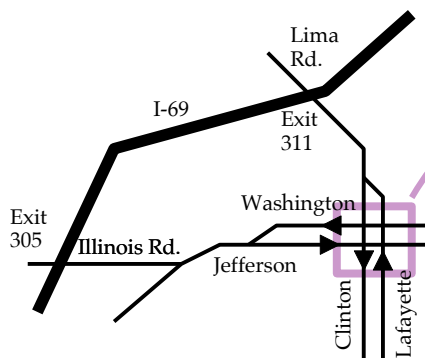
